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With al fresco season just around the corner, we've rounded up new contemporary outdoor lounge collections that encourage slowing down and soaking in the sun



When American furniture and industrial designer <u>Richard Frinier</u> first conceived Daydream 20 years ago for <u>Dedon</u>, he was inspired by his own wanderlust, Middle Eastern folk tales and a desire to offer an "invitation to the dreamer in us all." That aspiration translated into the now-iconic four-poster daybed immediately recognizable for its undulating lines, outward flaring vertical poles and billowing "fabric sky" canopy.





To honour Daydream's 20th anniversary, a new punchy Citrine colourway has been released for the daybed's distinctive Viennese cane-weaving (made with weather-resistant Dedon Fiber) that constitutes almost its entire structure. As bright as a sunny day, the new hue contrasts well with the gauzy fabric canopy, while the standard thick cushion and plump pillows enhance the comfort of a spot ideal for reading, snoozing or conversing pool or beach side. A matching sculptural side table has also been added to the Daydream collection.
